

Connecting an iPod, iPad or iPhone to the HWS Wireless network

To configure your iPod, iPad or iPhone for wireless network connection:

Note: In order to send the required file to your iPod/iPad/iPhone you must have an e-mail account already configured on your device. Your device must already be connected to a Wi-Fi or Cellular network to receive the e-mail outlined in these steps.

On your computer:

1. In your Web browser, navigate to <http://www.hws.edu/itservices/mobile/ipodiphone.zip>
2. At the prompt, save the folder to your desktop
3. Use an unzipping tool to extract the file **ipodiphone.mobileconfig** to the desktop
4. E-mail the **ipodiphone.mobileconfig** file as an attachment to the e-mail address you have configured on your iPod/iPhone

On your iPod/iPad/iPhone:

5. Open the e-mail containing the attachment
6. Click on the **attachment**
The configuration file will automatically open.
7. Click **Install**

8. In the warning screen that appears, click **Install Now**

9. When prompted in the next two screens, enter your **HWS username and password**

Setup is complete.



To connect the mobile device to the HWSWireless network:

1. On the device home screen, go to **Settings**



2. Within Settings, click **WiFi Connection**



3. From the list of available access points, select **HWSWireless**



4. When prompted, **accept the certificate**

The configuration will be saved after you accept the certificate, and the HWSWireless access point will be available any time it is in range.

In the future the only step required to connect to the HWSWireless network will be to select the access point from the list of available access points.
